



Nickel & Nickel "Searby Vineyard" Chardonnay 2009, Russian River Valley California \$90.

**91 POINTS WINE SPECTATOR**

Floral aromatics and Muscat flavors blend with essence of grapefruit and pear to provide a delicious palate. This enticing combination of fruit, oak and acidity creates a mouthwatering wine.

Nickel & Nickel "Vogt Vineyard" Cabernet Sauvignon 2008, Howell Mountain-Napa Valley CA \$180.

**92 POINTS STEVEN TANZER**

Classic Howell Mountain Cabernet. The smaller berries from this vintage offer a rich core of both fruit and tannin, while hints of tar and earth add layers of interest. French oak blends beautifully with the ripe fruit components.



Dutton Goldfield "Dutton Ranch" Chardonnay 2008, Russian River Valley California \$75.

**92 POINTS WINE ENTHUSIAST**

In the nose, aromas of lemon zest and tangerine are balanced by butter cream, pear and a hint of caramel. In the mouth it's all about the lively citrus fruit at first sip, but with time it's the overtones of pear and ginger, along with the lush mouth feel and phenolic edge that make the wine truly special.



Rochioli Pinot Noir 2009, Russian River Valley California \$150.

**92 POINTS WINE SPECTATOR**

This "cashmere in a bottle" possesses the typical Rochioli character and classic Russian River charm with black cherry and spice aromas. Aged in French oak for 15 months, the wine displays a full body and silky texture finish with a firm and balanced structure.



Willamette Valley Vineyards "Tualatin Estate" Pinot Noir 2008, Willamette Valley OR \$100.

**322 CASES PRODUCED**

Garnet red in the glass, this wine opens with vibrant, fruit forward aromas of black cherry, raspberry and blackberry, complemented by notes of dark chocolate, lavender, vanilla and pine. Flavors flow beautifully through the sip, starting with sweet cherry and moving through vanilla, spice and leather.



Duckhorn "3 Palms Vineyard" Merlot 2005, Napa Valley CA \$130.

**94 POINTS ROBERT PARKER**

Three Palms Vineyard is legendary in the world of California Merlot. A warm site with freedraining soils, Three Palms consistently delivers focused red-fruit flavors balanced by signature minerality.



Far Niente Cabernet Sauvignon 2007, Oakville-Napa Valley CA \$220.

**93 POINTS ROBERT PARKER**

This wine offers intense aromas of blackberry and boysenberry along with licorice and perfume. Well-integrated and melting tannins lead to a long and juicy finish.

Far Niente Chardonnay 2009, Napa Valley CA \$105.

**92 POINTS WINE SPECTATOR**

This amazing chardonnay offers aromas of Meyer lemon, honeysuckle and melon layered with toasted hazelnut and nutmeg. The entry is oily, long and silky with clean, bright acidity and fresh, tropical fruit flavors supported by sweet toasted oak.

**NEW RELEASE- UNRATED...BUT SURE TO BE WELL RECEIVED BY THE CRITICS**

Fragrant plum, raspberry and notes of cola, clove and white chocolate round out a delicate perfume. Sweet red currant and plum fruit flavors offer a silky mouthfeel. As it coats the mouth, concentrated dark fruit flavors emerge with succulent balanced tannins, a subtle impression of well-integrated oak and sweetness from the rich, ripe fruit.

Beringer Private Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2007, Napa Valley CA \$245.

**97 POINTS ROBERT PARKER**

One of the finest Private Reserves made over the last two decades, it exhibits a dense purple color as well as an extraordinary nose of blackberries, white chocolate, licorice, tobacco leaf, smoky barbecue, charcoal and a burning ember-like note reminiscent of a Graves from Bordeaux.



Leonetti Cellar Cabernet Sauvignon 2008, Walla Walla WA \$280.

**98 POINTS WINE ENTHUSIAST**

Seductive color saturation to the rim. The nose on the Cabernet Sauvignon captures what makes this one of the world's finest wine grapes—it is an exotic array of spices, dried herbs, lavender, charcuterie, mocha, cassis, vanilla, and ripe red and black fruits. The wine has incredible density, with very ripe tannin that is suave on the palate.

The beautiful nose displays cherries, wet stones, dried meats and a hint of cinnamon. This vintage is remarkably well balanced on the palate. The finish and mouth feel are lush and velvety making you long for your next sip.
